

Orange blanket

10 balls of big wool Rowan – colour Yolk

Needles US 13 or 9mm (or size to obtain desired gauge and size)

Gauge – before wash – 8sts x 14rows – 10cm x 10cm (4in x 4in)

Pattern consist of 36 sts and 24 rows

Cast on 102 sts.

1st row – k2, p2k1. Sl1

2nd row – k1, p1, k2, p2 p1, sl1

3rd row – As first row

4th row – As second row.

Optional 4th row instead: set up pattern (it is the wrong side of the blanket) as follows:

K1-5k-1p-2k-1p-4k-2p-4k-1p-2k-1p-5k-1p-2k-2p-2k-1p-5k-1p-2k-1p-4k-2p-4k-1p-2k-1p-5k-1p-2k-2p-2k-1p-5k-1p-2k-1p-4k-2p-4k-1p-2k-1p-5k-1slp

5th row (chart row 1): rs row: (k1, p5- border stitches) work chart row 1 two times then work chart row 1 stitches 1-18 one time, (p5, sl1- border stitches)

Odd rows: worked in pattern of previous row as they appear on wrong side. Knit the Knit stitches and Purl the Purl stitches as they appear on the wrong side.

Continue working chart pattern maintaining first six stitches and last six stitches as border stitches.

The second chart is the complete 102 rows charted for those that may find that easier to follow. Chart repeat is marked in red on this chart to make resizing the blanket easier also.

To finish:

Knit until you wish or until you have approximately only half of a ball of yarn. Stop the pattern after a wrong side row and repeat first 2 rows of border 2x ... Cast off.

Vertical border:

You will pick up approx 96 stitches on right vertical edge using the slipped stitches and knit 2k, 2p for 3 rows, cast off. Repeat on left side, cast off and you are done.

(WS) Sl 1 to back, p1, p st from cn



1/1 Left Purl
11lp

(RS) Sl 1 to front, p1, p st from cn
(WS) Sl 1 to back, k1, k st from cn



1/1 Right Cross
11rc

(RS) Sl 1 to back, k1, k st from cn
(WS) Sl 1 to front, p1, p st from cn



1/1 Right Purl
11rp

(RS) Sl 1 to back, p1, p st from cn
(WS) Sl 1 to front, k1, k st from cn
